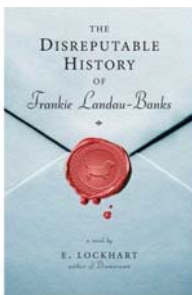
Good as Lily

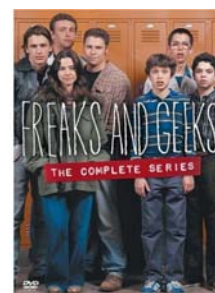
Cheater

In *Twilight* when 17-year-old Bella moves to Forks, Washington she meets gorgeous Edward Cullen, changing all her expectations. His mysteriousness captivates her, and she soon learns that he is a vampire. As Bella and Edward fall in love, she discovers loving a vampire is dangerous. The story continues in *New Moon*. Edward fears for Bella's life and leaves her. Edward then faces the Volturi, a powerful family of vampires in Italy. In the third novel *Eclipse*, the Cullens and Bella fight for their lives when a revenge-seeking vampire comes to Forks looking to kill Bella and anyone who gets in her way. A much anticipated fourth book, *Breaking Dawn*, is being released August 2nd. The final book in this love/action/fantasy series will wrap up the story of Bella and Edward.
