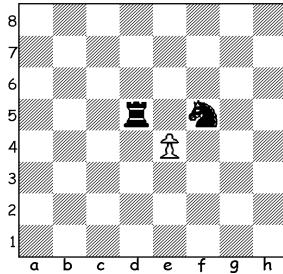
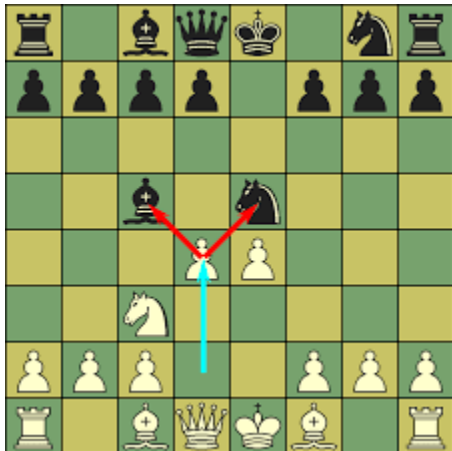


FORK

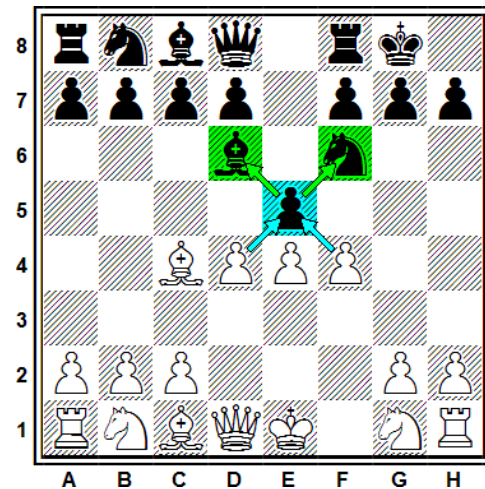
1. A fork is a kind of double attack.
2. Attacks two or more pieces simultaneously
3. Pawn – attacks pieces diagonally on squares of same color
4. Pawns never go backwards
5. Pawn chains help support the recapture of pieces



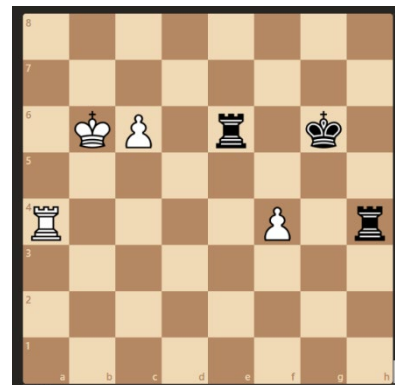
